Description

This 6-hour tabletop provides participants with knowledge, skills, and tools to assist in a community outbreak of Healthcare Associated Infections (HAI) and focus on respective agency roles and responsibilities. The HAI IMPACT tabletop is an exercise in training, building relationships, and evaluation.



Objectives

-  **RECOGNIZE AND RESPOND** to a Healthcare Associated Infection (HAI) outbreak.
-  **UNDERSTAND** infection control guidelines which prevent HAI's.
-  **DEVELOP** tools for their agency's infection control guidelines.
-  **IDENTIFY** the roles and responsibilities of community health partners during an HAI outbreak.
-  **UNDERSTAND** the role, strategies, and goals of the state and local Department of Health in HAI investigations.
-  **BE FAMILIAR** with Department of Health's HAI Program. Be familiar with CDC's Infection Control Assessment Tools.
-  **IDENTIFY** challenges and develop solutions in response to an HAI outbreak.

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
